President's Report – Bob Bedoll

Policy Committee report

Bob wants to replace our antiquated projector with a monitor in the McGoldrick Library. No other discussion at this time.

Weekend Staffing for the archival building

Bob reports good steady activity at the AB. Saturdays have more guests which could be attributed partially to the Saturday Farm Market. Peggy is forming a list of job descriptions for the docents to be posted on the website. Example: responsibilities and qualifications.

Farmhouse heat pump will be set at 60 degrees and adjusted when the house is in use. Directions will be given to the docents. (68 -70 degrees when occupied)

Archival Building Report - Ed Stephenson

New Archival Building Annex (Rick & Ed) - (All the paperwork has been submitted to the County. We don't know when they will review it. The contractor has given us a deadline for the end of September or they have the option of increasing the cost to AIHS).

New Policy on Grant Financial Reporting-

Bob would like a way to document the procedure to submit a grant. Also, for financial purposes, how to chart the disbursement of funds.

Building Status-

The building is in great shape.

Jeanne and Jane are looking for the proper lights for the new causeway. Still looking. p3

Generator Status

Ed, Rick and Bob will meet with Vista Electric to get a clear understanding of our needs for a back up generator regarding wattage, electric or auto start, set up etc.

Discussion of an AED for the archival building.

Lynne reports that a Red Cross representative came to the Island for a training. She is helping Lynne find the appropriate AED for our needs. Lynne hopes to order and have it available in about a month.

Status: Archival Building as a museum – Dick Throm

Both Dick and Rick are happy with how the AB is being used. To be clear Rick is responsible but Dick with help with displays if needed.

Archives- Rick Anderson

Archival report and committee status - The committee did not meet this month due to a schedule conflict

Rick went over the steps it requires to get a grant through. It is worth the work but requires a point person to see to the enormous amount of paperwork and the multiple steps required. Ed will write a procedure.

Displays Status -Melissa is working on a concept to expand one of the displays in Coop 2 into communications. Examples: radios, telephones, typewriters, computers.

Inventory/Cataloging Status - Slow; a team is needed for the Farmhouse.

Beau has been scanning pictures at home. Discussion was introduced regarding his internship renewal. There will be a huge project coming with pictures that need to be scanned. No resolution on continuation of the internship since he is "thinking about it". He has done a lot and helped us quite a bit.

Farmhouse Vision and Plan (Karen S) - Karen and Rick will figure out what needs to be moved to the AB or Coop 2.

Rick made a motion to proceed with digitizing Island Memoir and attach it to our website so researchers would have access and search capabilities. Cost not to exceed \$200. 2nd by Lynne. Discussion. Motion made to amend the cost to be raised to \$300. 2nd Peggy. Aye (Beau will be able to do the digitizing and put it on the AIHS website.)

AI Movie - It is proceeding but some parts are being redone. The expectation is for a release in January. Walt Melewski put a short trailer together. It may be shown at the film festival.

The vast amount of land originally held by the farm was said to go from 40 to 200 acres. Investigation of the holdings are being researched on the amounts as well as when, how and who were involved in the changes.

Liane located the deed of gift for the Gem Car. It was donated 6-29-2015 by Ron and Jacqueline Swallow from Tacoma. Rick will contact them to find out if they want it returned. If not, it will be sold, given away or gifted to a program that accepts this type of donation.
