### President's Report (Bob Bedoll)

# **Vice President's Report (Carol Pascal)**

Unanimous vote to insure the Annex Building for a replacement cost of \$100,000. Will re-visit in a year.

### **Treasurer Report (Todd Billet)**

- \$3500 projected cost to coat the Farm Buildings with linseed oil;
- Ed projected costs for the Archive Building to be \$2000;
- Contract for John at \$15/hour with 10 hours per month. Peggy made a motion and Jeanne seconded, motion passed;
- Wayne proposed an additional \$500 for the Orchard;
- Wayne proposed an additional \$1200 for maintenance on the tractor and equipment;
- Add \$1200 for Volunteer lunches for a total budget of \$2000 per year;

• 17 x 19 foot greenhouse was proposed for the south side of the mower shed

### Other new construction (Sutton -please review)

- Proposed picnic shelter 20 ft x 30 ft \$8500 for materials (shed roof) and concrete slab;
- Stage cover 16ft x 24ft, \$15000 for roof materials;
- Stage cover 16ft x 30ft \$17500; (does this include the cost to extend the stage?)
- Include hand rail on south side on steps on the east side;
- Work with Island Arts since they also have an interest in a covered bandstand.
